

PSC Meeting Minutes: Monday, April 25, 2011 8:00pm

President Mike Timbrook called the meeting to order at 8:15am.

Opening Comments:

Vice President Fundraising (Mike):

- *McDonalds cards going well, mass email will go out to parents there are a few teams he needs parent emails for U10B-B, U11G-G&B, U13B, U13G. Trying to alleviate some issues for the managers as well as keeping the coaches informed. Fundraising, field schedules, website/facebook. If manager/coach is gone we can reach teams not trying to sell or solicit anything. Still have another week on McDonald's each kid will get something special from Ronald McDonald House. Mike needs totals on per child basis. Fundraising is meant to help each individual player alleviate the financial burden on those who participate. Money will go directly back to the manager to give to the kids would be helpful if you send him the info in a spreadsheet. Whatever individual sold most will get money back in 1st, 2nd and 3rd place also. Winning team gets Mr. Freeze party. Deadline is end of April so please begin to collect money.*
- *Going forward, we will not be doing same \$20 card we will lower price to \$10 card. Send vendor suggestion to Mike if you have any ideas.*

- *If you want to volunteer team to work concessions please let Mike know. We supply product unless you want to bring in baked goods which are 100% profit to you. Concession will open next weekend. We have a lot of games scheduled on 7th and 8th.*
- *Saturday, May 7th BW3's will give 10% net proceeds on that day to the club if you say you are with Perrysburg Soccer Club. Blow up slides with small admission fee .50 cents will be at fields on May 7th as well.*
- *We are working on a couple of other fundraisers (Eric Stegman and Mike Thompson) things seem to be going well, please give us any feedback you may have.*
- *Mike handed out info on McDonald's fundraiser card \$10 each, looking at doing this for spring.*
- *Kevin Overy has been working on a couple of other fundraisers. Register your Kroger card to donate to Perrysburg Soccer Club every time you use it. Kevin's team gets check for about \$315 per quarter and not everyone participates. He will send info sheet on how to register he has program that will track each individual you just need to let him know who is on your team. Club keeps 10% rest goes to team.*
- *Working with Kistler Ford to raffle off 2011 Ford Explorer 2-year lease fully paid for. Raffle tickets will be \$20/each will be at PYSA Opening Day. Want to sell 3000 tickets but if not will go to 50/50 raffle.*

- **Boys U8-U14 Commissioner:**
 - *(U8-U14) – Nothing to report.*
- **Girls U8-U10 and U11-U14 Commissioners:**
 - *Keith Whitacre (U8-U10) – Nothing to report.*
- **Fields Commissioner: (Ian Graham)**
 - *Ian is looking for front loader to do some work out at Route 199. Jason McNamee working on this with him. Really want to fill the valley areas in the fields for safety of the players.*
 - *Ian also got aerator and spreader to help get fields in good condition.*
 - *If small sided games do not happen at Levis then they will be held at high school.*
 - *U10-U12 will probably be out at Rivercrest.*
 - *Fields were set up this weekend with some help but Ian did majority of work so please thank him.*
 - *Few issues at Rivercrest regarding set up on fields and it appears PYSA set up fields this past weekend. Please let Jorge know if any issues with nets/lines so he can contact PYSA point person. PSC hands are tied a little bit here so we apologize for any inconvenience.*
 - *If teams are not sure if game is happening after them please take corner flags down and put them in the shed. If you arrive and they are not put in please get them from the shed and put them up. Replacing flags is expensive so please do your part by helping to put them away. It is a team responsibility.*
 - *Ian got new game field signs, please put them back on your fields when your game is complete.*
- **Uniform Commissioner: (Aimee Parks)**
 - *Tiro 11 will be new uniform for next year. Still using Team Sports. Current uniform no longer available through Team Sports EuroSport has remaining stock. If you need uniform pieces order from EuroSport and then Team Sports will print it for you.*
- **Tournament Update: (Keith Whitacre)**
 - *Tournament Date is September 23 – 25*
 - *If you are going to tournaments outside area please publicize as much as you can.*
 - *Would like to have 2-3 coaches on girls and boys side to contact coaches they know to fill teams in their age brackets. This is a good way to get the teams here that you want to play so you don't have to worry about playing up divisions for competition.*
 - *Working on getting teams outside 90 mile radius.*
 - *Have 450 hotel rooms secured.*
 - *Would like ideas on coaches gift, will do pins for players again this year.*
 - *Eric Stegman working on sponsors for program. Cost would be about \$3000 and they would have whole back cover as advertiser.*

- \$500 for full size, \$250 for half page, \$100 for 3x5 ad. If team knows sponsor and they advertise they will give \$25 back to team.
- Still shooting for 120 teams.
- Email blasts are going out.
- Have list of out of town teams coming to BG Tournament so we are working on those coming to our tournament as well.
- Intent is to get 8 teams in each age group so we don't have problems making kids play up in higher age divisions. We will try to have every age group covered so we don't have same complaints as last year.
- Tie-Dye format again for shirts will take pre-orders again will probably only have long sleeve & hoodies at the tournament site. Would like to have name/number included on the pre-order form so shirts can be printed ahead of time.
- Same vendor for trophies as last year.
- Pins again for player bags.
- Unique coaches gift again.
- 3 v 3 tournament timing does not look good for this year. We are going to submit application to be regional site. We allow them to use space they do set-up, games etc. and we need to show that we are marketing it and provide volunteers. Proceeds to club based on number of teams that sign up probably about \$1000 for one day.

Committee and Other Reports:

- **Referee Assignor:**

- One thing to emphasize this year. About 20 referees and intention is to use them. Trying hard to work with each ref and come out and see each ref perform.
- Refs are newer and they will make some mistakes, please be patient.
- Young kids are still developing their criteria in reffing, some will be more certain on that than others.
- Main thing is Bob needs to know if any problems.
- Appearance, timeliness, professional are all things he wants to know about.
- Feel free to let him know about problems but know that his intent will be to work through them.
- Young ref was there Sunday, did a great job, needed a little help with the forms.
- Please help refs with forms if they need it.
- Please have his phone number to call if ref is not present. He tries not to schedule back to back crews but occasionally that happens and if game runs over crew could be late.
- If game is cancelled due to weather you have 3 days to reschedule with other team or the league will do it for you with a fee. Make sure you let Jason McNamee know if game is rescheduled so he can give you. Please contact Bob to let him know so he can make sure you have refs for the game. NWOYSL has to be notified of changes or they will charge you a fee.
- Call other coach and find a date that works.
- Call Jason and Ian for field availability.
- Call NWOYSL to notify them of change.
- Call Bob for referees.

Vice President Operations (Jorge):

- *U8B, U8G, U9B, U9G, U12B, U12G Tryout date is May 31st at Rivercrest*
- *U10B, U10G, U11B, U11G Tryout date is June 1st at Rivercrest*
- *U13B, U13G, U14B, U14G Tryout Date June 2nd at Rivercrest*
- *Jorge will send you names of person in charge of each age group. Small sided games will be emphasis we do not want kids standing in lines. If doubts about certain players they will put them in specific groups to watch.*
- *Please let him know if you can sign up to be evaluator.*
- *Will work with city on getting fields mowed.*
- *Jorge will set up fields for each age group.*
- *Everyone will get tryout manual please give Mike specific information on your particular age groups so he can hand out updated information.*
