Winter Training is almost here: Important Read

Winter training is mandatory for all PSC teams and will usually encompass the months of January to April. On the average teams will practice roughly once a week, but is team dependant. PSC will also schedule GK training sessions during the winter and teams will be required to send their GK's for this specialized training and please ensure you budget this into your winter fees (\$50).

Also, teams need to budget for the cost of a trainer/coach for their training sessions at a rate of \$25/hour (based on a D license scale)...your current/assigned coach will run your sessions and they are encouraged to bring in a guest coach or two for training sessions this winter.

Here's how the scheduling will work:

U8-U10's will train at Gold Medal Indoor (GMI)...I need the coaches to tell me what day of the week they want to train and the time they prefer ASAP so we can get a schedule and cost figured out. Also, if you want to combine with another team to split the cost of the field...i.e. U9 Gold & Black train together or split the field...saves money!! Let me know ASAP.

U11-U14's will continue to train at BGSU Field House. We will be meeting with BGSU within the next 10 days to review their preliminary list of dates/times for winter training. Wish list is to obtain as many weeknight consistent days/times starting at 5:45 and ending no later than 9pm. Also, we are looking into at least one full day and maybe a half day on Sunday to hold a tournament or scrimmages for the teams. Coaches, I would like your input on dates and times when Keith Whitacre gets the list from BGSU.

Teams are also encouraged to play indoor at either GMI or Soccer Spot and this fee is above and beyond your training session costs. Remember that you can combine with other teams to help reduce the cost for your teams.
