Time to start thinking about Winter Training:

Teams need to start thinking about winter training (Jan-Apr) as we will need to start reserving our time slots:

U8-U10's will continue to train at Gold Medal Indoor (GMI) and U11-U14's will continue to train at BGSU Field House.

Teams are required to participate in winter training and consists of an average of about one training session a week. PSC will also host GK training sessions during the winter and teams will be required to send their GK's to for this specialized training.

Teams are also encouraged to play indoor at either GMI or Soccer Spot and this fee is above and beyond your training session costs.
